Quality Of product: Did the Contractor comply with contract requirements and conformance with standards of good workmanship? <b>Great Denver Iron provided embed plates, pipe sleeves, wall penetrations, and wall frames for the project. GDI provided these fabricated items on schedule and without any quality problems.</b>	
b. Overall Customer Satisfaction: Are you satisfied with the completed work? Are you willing to work with this contractor again? <b>Yes</b>	
c. Timeliness of Performance: Did the contractor met or exceeded contract schedules? If not, did he have valid justification for delays? <b>GDI exceeded the contract schedule. GDI was able to fabricated and ship the items within 6-8 weeks which exceeded the contract lead time of 12-16 weeks.</b>
